

WHAT NOW?

If you have given your life to Jesus Christ:

1. Live for God and His eternal purposes.

"And whatever you do or say, let it be as a representative of the Lord Jesus (Christ)..." (Colossians 3:17)

2. Pray daily (talk to God).

Ask Him to help you learn to know His voice. Jesus said, "My sheep recognize My voice and they follow Me." (Matthew 10:27)

3. Read the Bible daily and live by it.

Begin with the "Gospel of John" in the New Testament. Discover God's love for you, the thousands of promises that are yours, and what God now expects from you as you grow to maturity in God.

4. Find a vibrant Christian church.

We were never meant to go it alone. Ask God to direct you to the local church that He wants you to be a vital part of. God has a church home for you. You can recognize good churches by their love for Jesus Christ, the Bible, and people. Go to Online Directories or Messianic Jewish Congregations.

5. Trust God who has the power to change things.

6. Tell others.

He told His disciples, "I have been given all authority in Heaven and Earth. Therefore go and make disciples in all the nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, and then teach these new disciples to obey all of the commandments I have given you; and be sure of this-that I am with you always, even to the end of the world." (Matthew 28:18-19)

7. Resist any urges to turn away from God.

"Forgetting what lies behind and straining forward to what lies ahead, I press toward the goal for the prize of the upward call of God in Christ Jesus." (Philippians 3:13-14)
